# ORDINANCE (ID # 3457)

Ordinance 23-09, an ordinance to amend the City of Bartlett Zoning Ordinance, by amending Article 1, Section 2, Definitions, to add Hookah Lounge and Other Smoking Lounges; and to amend Article V, Chart 1, Uses Permitted, to add Hookah Lounges and Other Smoking Lounges in the C-H Highway Business Zoning District with a Special Use Permit.

Ordinance 23-09, an ordinance to amend the City of Bartlett Zoning Ordinance, by amending Article I, Section 2, Definitions, to add Hookah Lounge and Other Smoking Lounges; and to amend Article V, Chart I, Uses Permitted, to add Hookah Lounges and Other Smoking Lounges in the C-H Highway Business Zoning District with a Special Use Permit.

WHEREAS, the Board of Mayor and Aldermen realize that hookah lounges and other smoking lounges throughout the United States have grown in popularity, supporting the use of smoking of tobacco products, cannabis, and other substances, and

WHEREAS, the effects of such businesses across the United States have contributed to noise, loitering, and, in some cases, a decrease in property values and an increase in crime within the vicinity of said lounges, and

**WHEREAS**, the effects of such businesses across the United States have, in some cases, diminished the protection of children and non-smokers from exposure to smoking and tobacco-related and other substance pollution; and

WHEREAS, regulating public hookah smoking and other public smoking protects community health. Current science shows that hookah smoking carries the same or similar health risks as cigarette smoking and may, in fact, be even more damaging. Hookah smoke contains significant amounts of nicotine, tar, heavy metals, and carcinogens. The smoke may also contain charcoal or cinder elements that release chemicals, such as carbon monoxide and metals, when burned; and

WHEREAS, the purpose of this Article is to regulate the location and operation of retail purveyors of hookah sales and other smoking products in order to maintain the character, diversity and vitality of the City of Bartlett's business districts and commercial areas and the quality of life for its residents and visitors. This is considered part of a strategy to preserve and enhance the economic health of the City's Business Districts and promote their continued positive development; and

**WHEREAS**, due to their demand and popularity hookah lounges and other smoking lounges, cafés, parlors and bars may be allowed in the City with a Special Use Permit within the "C-H" Highway Business Zoning District,

WHEREAS, the City of Bartlett Planning Commission reviewed the proposed amendment during its regular meeting held on December 4, 2023, and made a recommendation to the Board of Mayor and Aldermen that the proposed amendment be approved; and

**WHEREAS,** a public hearing before the Board of Mayor and Aldermen was held on January 9, 2024, pursuant to notice thereof published in a newspaper of general circulation on December 21, 2023.

**NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED** by the Board of Mayor and Aldermen of the City of Bartlett, Tennessee, that:

**Section 1**. That Article 1, Section 2, shall be amended to add the following definitions:

Ancillary Use shall mean a use that is supportive of and subordinate to any primary use.

Primary Use shall mean a use that is not an ancillary use.

Hookah lounge, parlor and/or bar and other smoking lounges shall mean any facility or location whose business operation, whether as its primary use or as an ancillary use, is denoted by the smoking of tobacco or other substances through one or more pipes (commonly known as a hookah, water pipe, shisha or narghile) designed with a tube passing through an urn of water that cools the smoke as it is drawn through it, including but not limited to establishments known variously as hookah bars, hookah lounges or hookah cafes and other types of smoking lounges using various smoking products. This definition also includes Electronic/Vapor Substance Inhalation Lounges where customers can smoke or inhale vapor from electronic/vapor substance inhalation products, commonly known as "electronic cigarettes", "e-cigarettes", "e-cigarellos", "e-pipes", "e-hookahs", electronic nicotine delivery systems", other similar devices, and other smoking products.

**Section 2**. That Article V, Chart I, of the Bartlett Zoning Ordinance, "Uses Permitted in the Zoning District," shall be amended as follows:

Chart 1. Uses Permitted in Zoning Districts
