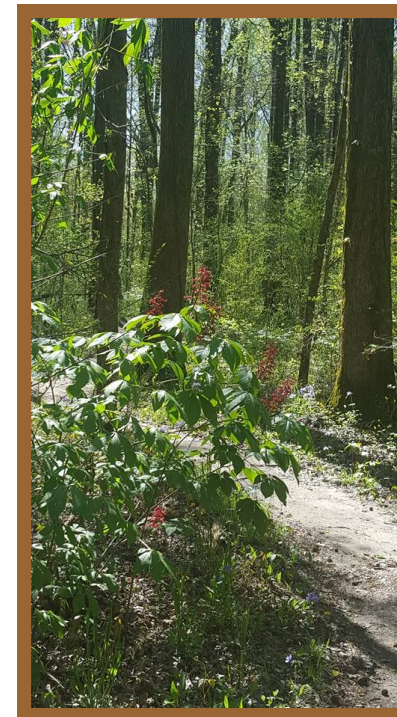

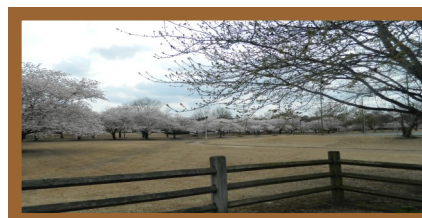

The park system serves the thriving City of Bartlett and its 57,670 residents, making it the 11th largest city in Tennessee. Due to Bartlett's success in creating an exceptional quality of life, an award-winning school district, a safe community and new housing inventory, young families are expected to continue to lead the community in sustained growth into the coming decades.

That is why the City of Bartlett and the Parks and Recreation Board established the Bartlett Parks Foundation Fund in 2016 as a tool to ensure that the beautiful, diverse and irreplaceable park lands can be maintained and enhanced for generations to come.
